Sewing Instructions

These instructions are designed for the beginner; the more advanced seamstress may of course employ her own techniques.

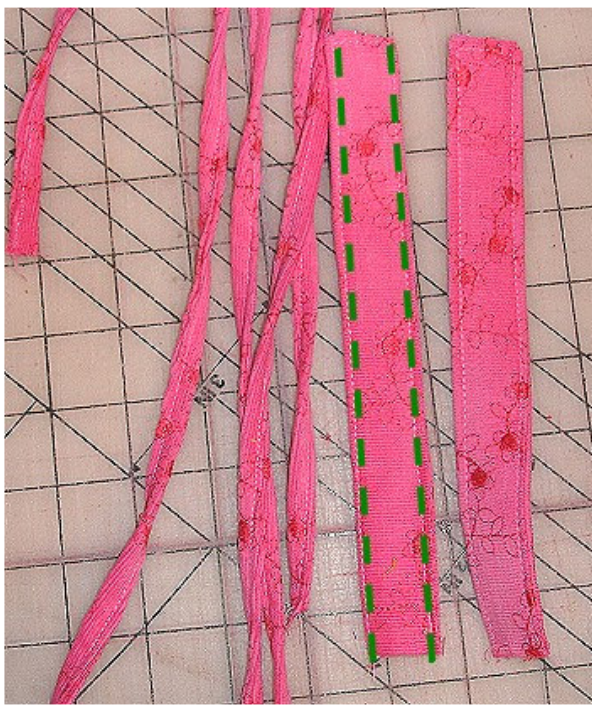


Description

Cut the pieces out according to the layout. Seam allowance is included for the straps and bindings - it is necessary to add seam allowance for the other pieces.



Fold strap pieces in half lengthways and press. Open out again and then fold both edges towards the middle and press again. Fold strap in half lengthwise.



Top stitch either side of strap. Repeat for the ties.



Serge the bottom seam of the bodice.



Take the straps and pin them to the right side of the front and back bodice lining pieces approximately 0.5 cm from the armhole seam line (green) and sew on the seam allowance.

Make sure that the pieces line up opposite each other.



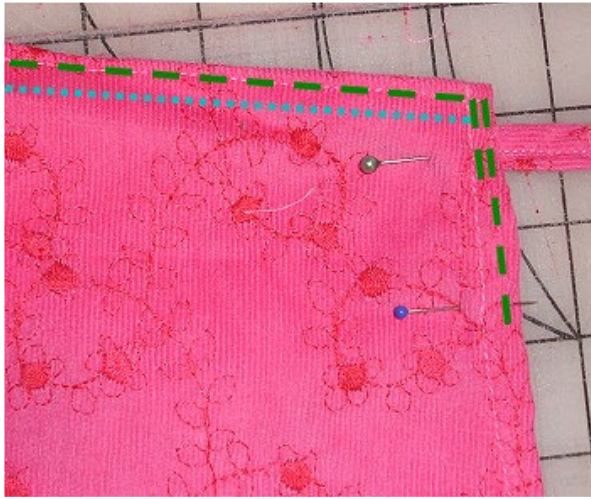
Pin the bodice lining and dress pieces right sides together sew along the top edge.



Trim and clip the seam allowance.



Hem the side edges of the two apron dress pieces beginning at the bodice.



Turn the bodice right side out and pin along the side seams. When doing so insert a tie between the bodice and the front and back apron pieces. Top stitch and

Sides and top seams of the bodice (green line), sewing

Back and fourth over the tie. Sew a second line of

Topstitching approximagely .5cm from the first (blue line)



Hem bottom and decorate dress as desired.
